



Book Information

Students in need of purchasing books and who have an expected credit balance due to excess Title IV funds will be given book vouchers in the amount of the expected credit. Vouchers will be attached to student schedules but can also be picked up in the SFS office until the second Tuesday after the start of the term should students not validate their schedule by the stated deadline. Vouchers can be redeemed in the bookstore for an amount equal to or less than the stated amount on the voucher until the second Tuesday after the start of the term. All costs in excess of the amount of the voucher will be the responsibility of the student at the time of purchase.

Students wishing to opt out of the voucher program may complete the opt-out section of the voucher and submit it to the SFS department at any time. Any student who does not redeem their voucher by the deadline is to be considered as opting out. Students who opt out of the voucher program and who have an expected credit balance due to receiving a Pell Grant will receive the lesser amount of either the amount of their Pell Grant excess or their full credit balance amount, for the term in question, within seven days of the start of the term. Students who opt out of the voucher program who have excess Title IV funds and who do not receive a Pell Grant will receive a stipend within the later of the term begin date or 14 days of the date of their credit balance as it appears on their ledger card.
