

Central Texas College and South University - Austin Articulation Agreement

Introduction

This Articulation Agreement recognizes that the Central Texas College District (CTC) located in Killeen, TX and **South University** - **Austin** located in **Round Rock**, **Texas** are active educational partners committed to providing greater educational opportunities and services for students transferring between institutions. This agreement supports the concept of a seamless transfer embracing the principle that transfer students should not be required to repeat competencies already achieved. CTC and **South University** - **Austin** enter into this agreement in the spirit of cooperation and mutually recognize each other as quality institutions of higher learning.

Purpose

The purpose of the agreement is to enable CTC students who transfer to **South University** - **Austin** to carry with them the credit they have already earned for as much relevant study as possible. The agreement provides a structure through which transfer articulation on all levels can be supported. South University - Austin understands and agrees that transfer articulation is with CTC as a whole and not with individual campuses within the district. Courses taken at any CTC location and by any delivery method are considered equally transferable.

Terms and Conditions

- 1- This agreement becomes effective upon signing by both institutions and shall remain effective until one or both institutions deem it necessary to terminate the agreement. Either partner may terminate this agreement upon 90 days signed, written notice to the other partner.
- 2- This agreement will be reviewed every two years by both institutions and any amendments must be proposed in signed writing.
- 3- The Appendix of the agreement that contains the crosswalk(s) may be amended as necessary to ensure relevant information is accurate and current.
- 4- Both institutions will designate an individual who will be responsible for the maintenance of the agreement.

- 5- CTC students who desire to transfer to **South University Austin** must meet the same standards and criteria for admission to a major degree sequence as a native South University Austin student.
- 6- **South University Austin** will encourage CTC transfer students to complete the appropriate Associates Degree either before matriculation to **South University Austin** or by reverse transfer of course credit following admission to and attendance at the **South University Austin**.
- 7- Once the student transfers, **South University Austin** will develop a reverse transfer credit process that includes the methodology to identify CTC transfer students who have earned at least 30 non-remedial credits at CTC and have earned a total of 90 cumulative credit hours of coursework. **South University Austin** agrees to provide CTC with a list of potentially eligible students and their transcripts each term provided student's consent to release information is obtained.
- 8- **South University Austin** agrees to share data related to CTC transfer students annually. Share data must include but is not limited to: number of transfer students, grades, degrees awarded, date enrolled and date graduated, etc. Both institutions agree to follow all Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) regulations or requirements.
- 9- **South University Austin** agrees to provide transfer students with information regarding the availability of transfer scholarships for eligible students as well as any other financial aid opportunities at **South University Austin**.
- 10- CTC agrees to inform students who are nearing graduation of transfer opportunities and what needs to be accomplished to meet transfer requirements.
- 11- **South University Austin** and CTC agree to cooperate in communicating information about this agreement. Each institution will: assume responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach their respective student populations, and will annually review the agreement and update the articulation webpage as necessary. Any use of the CTC logo will be approved in advance.
- 12- CTC agrees to invite **South University Austin** to campus transfer fairs and other applicable campus-wide events, etc. The Transfer Advisors at CTC will issue the invitation. **South University Austin** agrees to invite CTC to campus transfer fairs and other applicable campus-wide events. **South University Austin Student Affairs** will issue the invitation to CTC Transfer Advisors.
- 13- **South University Austin** and CTC agrees to post information about their partnership and transfer/reverse transfer opportunities on their web sites.

Course and Program Transfer Crosswalks

Academic crosswalks outlining the course-by-course transfer of courses and/or specific programs must be included in the appendix section of this agreement. A course-specific crosswalk is required for each transferrable program. Crosswalks approved after the initial signing of this agreement will be added and clearly identified as updates or amendments to this document and signed by the approving personnel of each institution.

Partnering Institution Information

South University is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges to award associate, baccalaureate, masters, post-graduate certificates and doctorate degrees. This agreement will be in effect beginning **June 1, 2021** and may be renewed by signed mutual consent of the two institutions. The agreement will be re-evaluated every two years. Either partner may terminate this agreement upon 90 days signed, written notice to the other partner.
