

South University – Orlando Prospective Disclosure Requirement:

I am a prospective student seeking enrollment in the Bachelors of Science in Nursing program.

I understand that I am seeking enrollment in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at the South University Orlando teaching site location that is currently pending programmatic accreditation approval from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

I understand the BSN program is approved by the Florida Board of Nursing, that the CCNE approval is pending, and that the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges has been notified of the intention to offer the program at the South University- Orlando location.

I understand that South University – Orlando submitted its request for accreditation to CCNE on May 8, 2020 and that the estimated CCNE approval process typically takes approximately 9 to 12 months to complete.

I understand that I must graduate from a CCNE accredited BSN program to be eligible to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) offered through the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN).

I understand that South University – Orlando will immediately notify me promptly of any relevant developments about the Orlando CCNE programmatic accreditation and upon receipt of the CCNE accreditation approval.

For prospective students seeking to utilize military benefits, South University – Orlando is seeking approval from the State Approving Agency and the Department of Veterans Affairs for eligibility. If you choose to enroll, you will not be eligible to use your military education benefits until approval is received.
