- > Full-time students may qualify for a grant of up to \$3,000.
- > Part-time students may qualify for a grant of up to \$1,500.

Recommit to Your Goals

To qualify for the Student Success Grant, you must*:

- > Be a returning South University student with a prior enrollment history
- > Be accepted into an eligible South University undergraduate program
- > Begin classes on or after 02/21/2019
- > Have a balance incurred during a prior enrollment(s) and have a financial shortfall in covering this balance after all applicable funding is applied
- > Meet minimum GPA requirements (varies by program) at time of disbursement
- > Have a signed Memorandum of Understanding on file
