This agreement with Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center will be in effect for the 2020/21 and 2021/2022 school years.

South University – Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center agree that students successfully completing the following courses at the Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center will receive credit at South University – Richmond:

Note: South University operates on a quarter system and credit hours reflect that system.

Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center students seeking admission into the Bachelor of Nursing program will be admitted into the pre-Nursing program. Admission to South University does not guarantee admission into the professional phase of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program.

To receive credit at South University - Richmond, Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center students must:

1. Apply and be admitted to South University – Richmond
2. Complete the Practical Nursing program at the Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center with a CGPA of 2.0 or higher
3. Submit an official Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center academic transcript documenting successful graduation
4. Enroll in courses at South University - Richmond

Both South University – Richmond and the Bridging Communities Regional Career and Technical Center agree to communicate any curriculum changes which may affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.
