Articulation Agreement with
SOUTH UNIVERSITY – RICHMOND**

This agreement with Chesterfield County Public Schools will be in effect for the 2020/21 school year.

South University – Richmond and Chesterfield County Public Schools agree that students successfully completing the Physical/Occupational Therapy I (VDOE code 8365) and Physical/Occupational Therapy II (VDOE code 8366) courses at the Chesterfield Career & Technical Center will receive credit for the following at South University – Richmond:

Chesterfield Career & Technical Center Course	South University – Richmond Course	Additional Coursework Requirements after enrolling at SURI to receive SURI credit
Physical/Occupational Therapy I (VDOE code 8365)	AHS1001 - Medical Terminology (4cr hr)	None
Physical/Occupational Therapy II (VDOE code 8366)	AHS1001 - Medical Terminology (4cr hr) BIO1011 – Anatomy & Physiology I (4cr hr), BIO1012 – Anatomy & Physiology I (Lab) (2cr hr)	None

Note: South University operates on a quarter system and credit hours reflect that system.

To receive credit at South University - Richmond, Chesterfield Career & Technical Center students must:


1. Apply and be admitted to South University - Richmond
2. Earn a minimum grade of "C" (70%) in the Chesterfield Career & Technical Center course listed in the table above
3. Submit an official Chesterfield County Public Schools academic transcript documenting successful graduation
4. Enroll in courses at South University - Richmond

Further, Chesterfield Career & Technical Center's instruction of Physical/Occupational Therapy I (VDOE code 8365) and Physical/Occupational Therapy II (VDOE code 8366) will be based on South University's Administrative Course Outlines for AHS1001 - Medical Terminology, BIO1011 – Anatomy and Physiology I, and BIO1012 – Anatomy & Physiology I (Lab) and utilize the same textbooks currently employed by South University in the corresponding courses.

Both South University – Richmond and the Chesterfield Career & Technical Center agree to communicate any curriculum changes which may affect the agreed upon relationships between articulated courses at the respective schools.
