Articulation Agreement Between South University and Compu Med Vocational Careers

I. Purpose

The purpose of this articulation agreement (the Agreement) is to establish procedures and guidelines for students who complete the Associate of Science in Nursing degree at Compu Med Vocational Careers to enroll in the RN-BSN program at South University.

II. Elements of the Agreement

A. Admission to South University

Students who have completed the Associate of Science in Nursing degree at Compu Med Vocational Careers will be reviewed as pre-qualified for the South University's RN-BSN program. Applicants will be required to complete all South University admissions requirements in effect at the time of application. Requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Science in nursing program can be found in the latest version of the South University Academic Catalog.

B. Credit Transferability

- Students who have completed the Associate of Science in nursing degree at Compu Med Vocational Careers will be accepted as transfer students at South University (see Attachment).
- 2. The final results of a transfer review are contingent upon receipt of official transcripts. South University reserves the right to make a final determination on all matters related to transferability and course equivalencies.

C. Coordination

- 1. South University and Compu Med agree to:
 - a. Coordinate their efforts to facilitate a collegial and mutually beneficial relationship;
 - Provide accurate and timely information about the articulation agreement to prospective South University students, including current students at Compu Med Vocational Careers as well as graduates, and;

c. Designate an academic alliance coordinator as the primary contact person for the respective institutions to facilitate coordination of this agreement.

2. South University agrees to:

- a. Compu Med Vocational Careers with all relevant application and transfer of credit information and current South University Academic Catalogs and Bachelor of Science in Nursing program brochures;
- b. Communicate with Compu Med Vocational Careers students and graduates who request information regarding South University's RN-BSN program via email, postal mail, telephone, and other means to offer them the opportunity of enrolling at South University. South University will ensure proper consent prior to contacting these students.
- c. Participate in any Compu Med Vocational Careers education and career events if available.
- d. Encourage Compu med students to enroll at South University after graduating from the Associate of Science in nursing program.
- e. Provide Compu Med Vocational Careers with contact information that their current students, soon-to-be graduates and alumni can use to connect with a South University advisor.
- f. Provide a tuition scholarship of 10% for the duration of their program to graduates of the Associate of Science in nursing program.

3. Compu Med agrees to:

- a. Assist South University by communicating on its website and through the Student Support Services Transfer Coordinator, the benefits of this articulation agreement to Compu Med Vocational Careers students and graduates.
- b. Up to four times per year allow South University representatives to conduct on campus presentations and marketing regarding the South University bachelor degree programs for Compu Med Vocational Careers students and graduates.

c. Approved South University's program summary sheets will be distributed to Compu Med Vocational Careers students, graduates, staff, and faculty about the Agreement.

III. Terms

A. This agreement is effective for the South University academic term beginning with the date of the fully executed document, and shall continue until terminated. Both parties must approve amendments to the Agreement in writing. Changes to this agreement, or its termination, shall not adversely Compu Med Vocational Careers students who subsequently enrolled at South University under this agreement.

- B. Either party may terminate the Agreement upon 90 days' written notice to the other party.
- C. The foregoing notwithstanding, either party may terminate the Agreement immediately in the event that participation under the Agreement may give rise to a violation of any requirement of federal or state law or regulation or the requirements of any accrediting agency having jurisdiction.
- D. Admission criteria and academic and other requirements will be subject to the South University catalog at the time of the student's admission to South University. Active students at the time of termination will be grandfathered into their selected program.

E. The Agreement may be executed by either electronic or facsimile transmission in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original.

Attachment (Articulation Agreement)

Students will be eligible to transfer up to 94 semester credit hours towards South University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree with a completed Compu Med Vocational Career Associate of Science in Nursing Degree.

To be eligible for consideration, students must complete an Associate of Science in Nursing at Compu Med Vocational Careers. All advanced standing requests must be approved by the Program Chair, subject to receipt of official transcripts.

Students must earn a C- or better for transfer, unless otherwise specified by programmatic requirements (Note: For transfer credit from colleges that award plusses or minuses, the plus or minus will be dropped when the course is transferred to South University).
