

COVID-19 Testing – South University

You can choose to seek COVID-19 testing through an in network primary care physician, urgent care, or state funded testing location. If you are experiencing symptoms, COVID-19 testing is covered in full for in-network providers for active Anthem South University medical participants. If you do not participate in South University's Anthem medical coverage, you can contact your current insurance provider. The state government may also offer additional state funded testing options.

Option One - South University Anthem Medical Plan – General Search

To search for an in network Primary Care Provider or Urgent Care Facility with Anthem:

- Visit <https://www.anthem.com/find-care/>
- Select "Guests"
 - *What type of care are you searching for? – Medical*
 - *What state do you want to search in? – The state where you are searching for coverage*
 - *What type of plan do you want to search with? – Medical (Employer-Sponsored)*
 - *Select a plan/network*
 - Georgia Residents: Blue Open Access POS
 - All Others: National PPO (BlueCard PPO)

Option Two - South University Anthem Medical Plan – Sydney App

To search for an in network local COVID-19 testing site with your Anthem Sydney App:

- Download the Sydney Health app on your mobile device
- Register for an account, or login to your current account
- Click "learn more" on the COVID-19 Symptom Checker from the home page flyer
- Scroll to the bottom of the screen and click "Find a COVID-19 Test Facility"
